5. Minutes were discussed and approved from March 6th and 8th Rockhill Tennis Club information meetings.
6. Parks and Points:
Rosehill will plant the pots with a red theme including Superbells Red Petunia, Spreading Sunset Lantana and Goldilocks Lysimachia (lime green trailer). Jill Dewit requested funds for the following plants and mulch and the board approved \$500 for this project:

20 Plants in Happy Woods = \$90

Trees and shrubs in Happy Woods = \$100

20 Plants on 54th & Cherry island = \$90

Mulch = \$150

Jill will coordinate the labor. Eileen asked since it was very physically demanding work in the past if CHA is liable for any injury incurred while helping with Jill’s project. The board agreed CHA is not liable. Board approved \$500 for Jill’s project and decided to wait on Cherry Woods park improvements until next year.

7. Paul mentioned increase on CHA insurance from \$250 to \$750. Paul asked Fox to look for a better plan, but Fox said this is what is available to us. Board agreed these types of increases need to be mentioned at the annual meeting when discussing potential need for neighborhood dues increase.
8. John brought up using a different host for our neighborhood website. Board acknowledged a back up of the site needs to be done. If Scott cannot do it Ken Spare's son in law may be able to. Board will continue to discuss using an outside company in the future.
